Strategic Plan Goal:

1) The WRVSU will form and sustain a comprehensive MTSS that:

- Utilizes evidence based best practices in instruction
- Utilizes student data to ensure student growth
- Encourages a rigorous, innovative and relevant learning environment
- Encourages the integration of PLP and Flexible Pathways to best meet the needs of all students.
 - **Data Team meetings have been set up. Teachers are meeting with our MTSS team to analyze student data, looking for student growth and problem solving where needed.**
 - **MTSS team conducted a self assessment around the school-wide MTSS system as a way to see where there may be gaps, or areas to improve. This was recommended by Michaela Martin who is working with the SU admin team around the area of building a high quality MTSS.**

2) WRVSU will implement a PK-12 Proficiency Based Learning System.

WRVSU school will utilize a comprehensive approach to ensure relevancy, rigor, and personalization. This will be achieved through the following:

- Curriculum
- Instruction
- Assessment
 - **On October 16th and November 6th the head teachers took part in the two of 10 professional development days surrounding early numeracy understanding.**
 - **Teachers continue to familiarize themselves with F and P materials. Currently they are working on familiarity with the phonics portion of the kits.**

3) The WRVSU will improve student learning and increase equitable

educational opportunities through the development of a culture that promotes interdependence among all stakeholders and enhances student achievement, choice and voice.

- **Teachers met to discuss students that are having some troubles with Social/Emotional issues. In the past we have had a system where teachers had mixed age groups of students called, CARE groups, to connect with and to have as advisors. This year COVID has put that on hold, so we are thinking creatively on how we can continue to check in with these students. Teachers will make a point to connect with their CARE group students via letters and face to face interactions. They will not be grouping students together at this point.**
- **Parent/Guardian conferences are set for November 11th. These will be done virtually this year. The goal for these conferences is to provide feedback to parents about how their child is doing academically and social emotionally. This is also a chance for parents to ask questions.**
