### January 4th - January 8th - Virtual Week

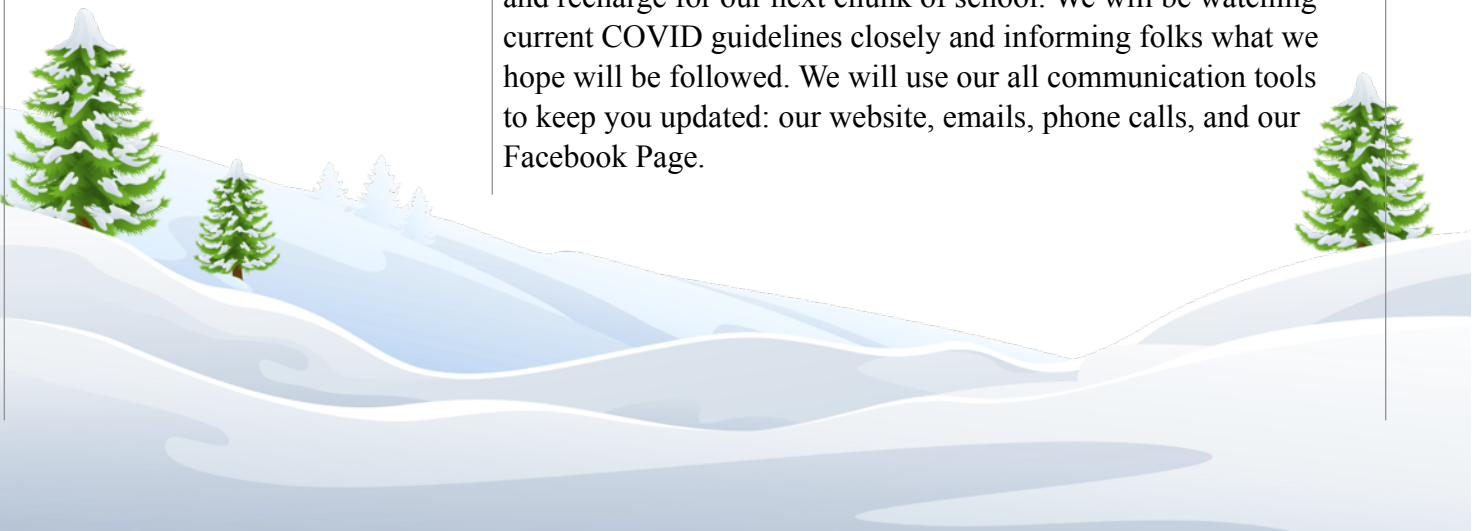
