Currently teachers and Mr. Haley are using math warm up strategies to get students engaged prior to the main lesson. These warm up activities not only are engaging, they are fun. As teachers conduct these activities, they are able to see where students may have gaps in their thinking, or if they have a solid grasp of the topic.**

3) The WRVSU will improve student learning and increase equitable educational opportunities through the development of a culture that promotes interdependence among all stakeholders and enhances student achievement, choice and voice.
