### Strategic Plan Goal:

1) The WRVSU will form and sustain a comprehensive MTSS that:

- Utilizes evidence based best practices in instruction
- Utilizes student data to ensure student growth
- Encourages a rigorous, innovative and relevant learning environment
- Encourages the integration of PLP and Flexible Pathways to best meet the needs of all students.
  - **Grades 3 and 6 have reassessed students using our STAR 360 assessment program. We are happy to announce that we are seeing an increase in scores from the beginning of the year. In fact, all third grade students have achieved proficiency or above.**
  - **Data Teams continue to meet to analyze data and to see what next steps are needed for student achievement.**
  - **Interventionist Laura Lewis is meeting weekly with teachers to continue to implement best practices in literacy instruction. Laura has been instrumental in providing knowledge around this area.**

2) WRVSU will implement a PK-12 Proficiency Based Learning System.

  - **We continue to familiarize ourselves with MTSS. Currently a school assessment is being conducted to see where we stand in our development of MTSS.**
  - **Teachers are continuing to explore best practices in math instruction. Together we aim to identify core aspects of mathematics instruction that should be evident in all classroom instruction.**

3) The WRVSU will improve student learning and increase equitable

educational opportunities through the development of a culture that promotes interdependence among all stakeholders and enhances student achievement, choice and voice.

- **Principal Haley is organizing a student council. Students will be invited to bi-weekly meetings with the Principal to discuss a variety of topics ranging from student and teacher expectations, the use of technology, analysing of assessment and more.**
