Strategic Plan Goal:

1) The WRVSU will form and sustain a comprehensive MTSS that:

- Utilizes evidence based best practices in instruction
- Utilizes student data to ensure student growth
- Encourages a rigorous, innovative and relevant learning environment
- Encourages the integration of PLP and Flexible Pathways to best meet the needs of all students.
 - **Kindergarten has completed the BAS (literacy) assessment as well as the PNOA (math) assessment.**
 - **Grades First and Second have completed the BAS assessment and the STAR 360 Math assessment.**
 - **Grades Three through Six have completed the BAS assessment, STAR 30 Literacy assessment and the STAR 360 Math assessment.**
 - **We will use the data from these assessments to inform our instructional practices and guide our professional development plan.**

2) WRVSU will implement a PK-12 Proficiency Based Learning System.

WRVSU school will utilize a comprehensive approach to ensure relevancy, rigor, and personalization. This will be achieved through the following:

- Curriculum
- Instruction
- Assessment
 - **During our half day inservice on January 22nd, the staff took time to analyze how their math instruction has changed based on our work with math consultant, Lorree Silvas. With a goal to identify key components of quality math instruction, the staff is at a good place in our journey.**
 - **Michaela Martin , from Central Vermont Supervisory Union, has shared a blueprint document from their continuous improvement plan centered on math. We will use this as a guide as we begin to build our own blueprint.**

3) The WRVSU will improve student learning and increase equitable educational opportunities through the development of a culture that promotes interdependence among all stakeholders and enhances student achievement, choice and voice.

- **Our Student council has been established. Representatives from the 3rd through the 6th grade class will meet bi-weekly to discuss a variety of issues concerning school improvement.**
- **Our fourth grade class has signed up to participate in, Bridge Up: Shakespeare in Schools at Northern Stage. This will be a 5 week virtual experience for our students.**
