Strategic Plan Goal:

1) The WRVSU will form and sustain a comprehensive MTSS that:

- Utilizes evidence based best practices in instruction
- Utilizes student data to ensure student growth
- Encourages a rigorous, innovative and relevant learning environment
- Encourages the integration of PLP and Flexible Pathways to best meet the needs of all students.
 - **We are working with a local woman, Donna Issacs, on developing protocols to look at student data. Donna has a wealth of experience and is offering her help to our school free of charge. We will be working with her throughout the school year to better understand how to look at data and use it to inform our instruction.**
 - **We are beginning to think about the 21-22 school year and what we would like to provide to our students that will give them opportunities to use their learning outside of the classroom. The idea that learning is relevant has become a driving force when creating learning opportunities for our students.**

2) WRVSU will implement a PK-12 Proficiency Based Learning System.

WRVSU school will utilize a comprehensive approach to ensure relevancy, rigor, and personalization. This will be achieved through the following:

- Curriculum
- Instruction
- Assessment
 - **Two of our teachers are conducting an audit on our literacy program and math curriculum as a part of their Masters. This work will inform our decision making when it comes to developing our curriculum that will identify key features to each instructional day.**
 - **Teachers will begin to develop classroom based assessments that help inform teaching. Using the Williamstown Elementary model of developing math assessment at the local level, we hope to achieve our own set of assessments that can be used PreK-6 to help identify gaps in learning for our students.**

3) The WRVSU will improve student learning and increase equitable

educational opportunities through the development of a culture that promotes interdependence among all stakeholders and enhances student achievement, choice and voice.

- **The 6th grade class successfully organized a school wide winter carnival. The students planned, ran and reflected on the experience. They will use this as a platform for organizing future school events.**
- **The administrator is looking to connect with the Town to find ways that students can be a voice in town government. Mr. Haley will contact the selectboard for their input or any ideas that they have.**
- **Our student council has successfully made a school meal survey and will conduct the survey starting the week of March 9th. From this survey we hope to create a breakfast and lunch menu that meets the needs and likes of the students.**
